

MATCH BASED DISCIPLINE KEY POINTS

- Season 2012/2013 all football will receive match based suspensions i.e. Saturday, Sunday, Midweek, Youth, Schools, Veterans and representative football.
- Small sided football will remain time based (days).

STANDARD CHARGES (RED CARDS)

- If you have a player sent off it is a FACT the player will be suspended **21 days** after the date of the game, Even if you do not receive paperwork from the County.
- If a player is sent off on a Saturday in open aged football the suspension will be from Saturday type football only. The player can still play Sundays, Youth and any other type.
- If a player is **sent off on a Sunday** in open aged football the suspension will be from Sunday type football only. **The player can still play Saturdays, youth and any other type**.
- If a player is **sent off in youth football**, the suspension will be from youth type football only. The player **can still play Schools**, **open aged and any other type football**.
- Qualifying matches for a suspension can only be for the **team** whom the player was playing
 for at the time they were sent off. e.g. if the player was sent off for the 1st team, the matches
 that qualify for the suspension are the 1st team matches, not the reserves or U18's etc.
- Claims of wrongful dismissal must be notified to the County office within 1 working day of the fixture.
- A DVD/Video showing the full incident leading to the dismissal together with the appeal fee and written reasons for the claim of wrongful dismissal must be with the county office within **3 working days of the fixture**.
- Time limits for a claim are strict, claims received late will not be considered. If there is no DVD/Video footage a claim for wrongful dismissal **CANNOT** be made.
- The DVD/Video MUST show the match official made a serious and obvious error.
- A dismissal from the field of play for **S6** (using offensive and/or insulting and/or abusive language and/or gestures) or **S7** (receiving a 2nd caution in the same match) **is not within the criteria for a claim of wrongful dismissal.**



MISCONDUCT CHARGES

- Misconduct charges are offences that do not fall under the standard dismissal offences, serious offences, or offences committed after the player is dismissed from the field of play.
- Punishments for **serious** offences will be set as days, not matches.
- If a player receives a misconduct charge and it is found proven, the player will be suspended
 from ALL football until the team he was playing for when the offence was committed serves
 the qualifying amount of fixtures imposed. e.g. if the player receives a 3 match ban for a
 misconduct charge the player cannot play any type football on ANY day until the
 suspension has been served.

OTHER

- If a player receives a set number of cautions (5, 10, 15 etc) during the qualifying period they will receive a suspension, this will commence 21 days from the date of the fixture the 5,10,15 caution was received, **even if you have not received notification from your county.**
- If a player received 5 cautions on a Saturday they will be suspended from Saturday football only. If a player received 5 cautions on a Sunday they will be suspended from Sunday football only. If a player received 5 cautions in youth football, the player will be suspended from youth football only.
- If a player receives 2 cautions on a Saturday and 3 cautions on a Sunday the player will not be suspended as they have not received 5 cautions for the same type of football. The caution count is also categorised between clubs outside the National League System and those between steps 5-7.
- Players who are dismissed from the field of play for a 2nd time in the same season , in addition to the automatic suspension applicable to the offence , will be suspended for 1 extra match, a 3rd time in a season, 2 extra matches and so on.
- If there are not enough fixtures left in a season to complete a suspension the player is free
 from suspension between the last qualifying fixture of the season and the opening qualifying
 fixture of the new season.
- NON RECEIPT OF PAPERWORK IS NOT A VALID DEFENCE WHERE A CHARGE IS ISSUED FOR PLAYING WHILST UNDER SUSPENSION. IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED CORRESPONDENCE RELATING TO A DISCIPLINE INCIDENT WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE FIXTURE IT IS THE CLUBS REPSONSIBILITY TO CONTACT THE COUNTY OFFICE IMMEDIATELY.
